- You may be nominated for one or all of these offices: President, Vice President, Secretary, or Area Representative (only for your area).
- Candidates should prepare a 5-minute speech to deliver at the Mid-Winter (January) Retreat.
- All the above information must be **turned in by February 25**. If you received this info late, please contact Claude Johnson directly regarding running for an office.
